hank you for flying with Japan Airlines. August is a time when many in Japan go crazy for high school baseball. At that age in the little league, we all had different physiques and ability, but we helped each other and practiced our own thoughtout tactics that made the most of our unique abilities. This gave us confidence and created a strong bond within the team. And then we amazingly won a tournament in the fall of sixth grade. That wonderful memory remains firmly in my mind and in Mibe's too, and even though the stage has moved away from the baseball ground to the corporate and social world, those recollections are still alive and well.

The 30th Baseball Fair is scheduled to take place in Japan next year, and as chairman of the WCBF, Oh Sadaharu says, "In children's baseball, young people of different genders and nationalities play together.
